## THE DEBUT OF PROJECT AMERICAN HEROES 2



August 10th, 2008. The Project American Heroes 1969 Camaro is escorted to the stage while the world waits patiently for its unveiling during the opening ceremonies for the Super Chevy Show in Joliet, Illinois. The thousands in attendance were on their tippy-toes trying to sneak a peak.



As the cover was removed by the builders from Route 66 Motorsports, the Camaro's bright red paint, American flag inlaid side stripe, and Stinger hood were revealed to the applause and awe of everyone in the grandstands.



This one-of-a-kind Camaro marks the second year of partnership between Super Chevy Magazine and the Armed Forces Foundation. The first PAH car raised \$130,000, and we expect this perfect machine to match or exceed that performance when it's auctioned off at the Barrett-Jackson auction in Palm Beach, Florida.
